Public Comment Period

WHAT IS THE PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD?

The public comment period:

- ➤ Begins with publication of a Notice of Availability (NOA) in the *Federal Register* stating the Draft EIS is available for comment.
- > Provides the public and interested stakeholders an opportunity to review the Draft EIS.
- > Is an open process for identifying issues that should be addressed in the Final EIS.

The U.S. Department of the Air Force (DAF) published an NOA in the Federal Register on November 9, 2023, announcing the Draft EIS for T-7A Recapitalization at Laughlin Air Force Base, Texas for public comment.

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER THE PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD?

After the public comment period, DAF:

- > Incorporates public comments into the development of the Final EIS.
- > The Final EIS is expected to be complete in early to mid-2024.
- > A Record of Decision could be signed no sooner than 30 days after the Final EIS is completed.
